- 2. The Member secretary appreciated the Investigators whose proposals received grants for 2019-2020 periods. - 3. Following the protocol two to three proposals pertaining to each forthcoming call were brought for discussion. The Investigators were called for presentation before the research board. The team of Investigators whose proposal convinces the board are given further approval to proceed with the submission process.
- 4. The members representing the respective schools and research centres were asked to instruct the concerned investigators to submit a report on the status of the execution of the respective projects including JRF/SRF recruitment, purchase of equipments/chemicals/consumables, outcomes of projects including patents, publications, products etc.,.
- 5. Budget for execution of the project was discussed and the chairperson instructed the concerned investigators to proceed with the procurements upon approval. The purchase files of all the operating projects were reviewed and necessary corrections were recommended.
- The log books pertaining to the respective projects were also reviewed to verify the stock enlisting the purchase of chemicals, consumables, glassware and other miscellaneous purchases relevant to the operation of the project.
- 7. The committee members appreciated the new projects sanctioned to the following faculties;
- Dr. D Inbakandan received a grant of Rs. 33.97 lakhs from BRNS, Govt. Of India for the project entitled "Development of antifouling technologies against green mussel fouling for process cooling of water system of MAPS"
- Dr. K Govindaraju received a grant of Rs. 1,90,000/- for the project titled "Preparation of biogreen carbon dots as a potent and trackable antimicrobial "Preparation of biogreen carbon dots as a potent and trackable antimicrobial DIRECTOR (RESEARCH)


