- 2. Various calls from Ministries and funding agencies were presented to the committee.





The draft proposals were encouraged to be submitted atleast 20 days before the deadline for the committee to approve for the submission. Respective School deans and Centre heads shall put forth together the proposals submitted from their school or centre. The Chairperson and the member secretary's decision on approval of the proposals to be submitted for funding is final.

- 3. Following the protocol two to three proposals pertaining to each forthcoming call were brought for discussion. The Investigators were called for presentation before the research board. The team of Investigators whose proposal convinces the board are given further approval to proceed with the submission process.




