
The Chairman and the Member Secretary welcomed the members and opened the floor for discussion;



 - 3. The members representing the respective schools and research centres were asked to instruct the concerned investigators to submit a report on the status of the execution of the respective projects including JRF/SRF recruitment, purchase of equipments/chemicals/consumables, outcomes of projects including patents, publications, products etc.
 - Budget for execution of the project was discussed and the chairperson instructed the concerned investigators to proceed with the procurements upon approval. The purchase file of all the operating projects was reviewed and necessary corrections were recommended.
 - 5. The log books pertaining to the respective projects were also reviewed to verify the stock enlisting the purchase of chemicals, consumables, glassware and other miscellaneous purchases relevant to the operation of the project.
 - 6. Announcement of proposals for submission for SEED grants was made to encourage the faculty to research in upcoming need of the hour research areas with the involvement of students from the different Engineering and Humanity Schools.




