

- 9. Budget for execution of the project was discussed and the chairperson instructed the concerned investigators to proceed with the procurements upon approval. The purchase file of all the operating projects was reviewed and necessary corrections were recommended.
- The log books pertaining to the respective projects were also reviewed to verify the stock enlisting the purchase of chemicals, consumables, glassware and other miscellaneous purchases relevant to the operation of the project M.S. (By Research), Ph.D.


