
The Chairman and the Member Secretary welcomed the members and opened the floor for discussion;


- The members were instructed to collect details of the research proposals under preparation from the various departments and research centres. Dr.V.Ramesh Kumar was instructed to compile the details.

Both the members highlighted the same. A total of 23 projects worth 2.42 crore were sanctioned till the date of the meeting, they mentioned.




